

# NEW ONTARIO PRODUCTION STATISTICS RELEASED BY TOARC

TOARC has recently released draft 2006 production information for Ontario. Some highlights are:

- Overall production for the province is up slightly at 177 million tonnes (up from 174 million tonnes for 2005).
- Production for Halton Region is down to 9.7 million tonnes, which represents a drop of 1.3 million tonnes from 2005 figures.
- Durham Region production is down to 12.2 million tonnes, which represents a drop of 1 million tonnes from 2005.
- Kawartha Lakes production is down slightly, but Simcoe, Hamilton, Caledon, North Dumfries, and Brant are all up. Wellington County production is up overall, but Puslinch is down slightly.
- On the rehabilitation front, new rehabilitated area is still outpacing disturbed area at a ratio of 2:1 in Aurora District, and it is getting closer to even for Cambridge District. Aylmer District is also rehabilitating more than is being disturbed.
